

Community Center Policies + Conduct

The Powell Community Center (PCC) was built for the recreational enjoyment of Mission residents and guests. Patrons seek a welcome and safe atmosphere to assemble and participate in growth activities. Treat the facility, patrons and staff with respect and adhere to all PCC Policies + Conduct. These policies will be strictly enforced to ensure behavior does not infringe upon other's use and enjoyment of the PCC.

- Participants must check-in at the front desk to gain entry to the facility. All guests must pay for a day pass or be enrolled in a City program/event or rental to access these facilities.
- Using another participant's pass to gain access is prohibited.
- Appropriate athletic apparel including: non-revealing shirts or swim suits, athletic shorts/pants + closed toed/closed heel athletic shoes must be worn in fitness areas.
- Youth under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or responsible person 16+ years.
- Food, gum + open drinks are not allowed in the pools, gym, track and/or fitness rooms.
- Alcohol, smoking + tobacco products are not permitted.
- Offensive language is not permitted.
- Only registered service animals are allowed in the facility.
- No abuse of facility furnishings & fixtures; no dunking on basketball rims.
- No commercial activities: private instruction, requesting donations, collecting admission, selling products, or soliciting individuals.
- State & local policies, laws + regulations must be observed at all times.
- Headphones must be used while listening to personal music.
- Get permission for any photography or videography, (personal or otherwise) from staff prior to filming.
- Advertising is exclusively for the City of Mission
- Use of bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, hover boards + drones are prohibited inside.
- Personal belongings must be secured in lockers; the PCC is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.

Failure to comply with staff requests, directions or instructions will result in loss of privileges up to and including: suspension, removal from the building or criminal trespassing.
